**Community Service compliance includes volunteering:** Enrich your life through volunteering! Below are some possible locations:

1. Local public or nonprofit institutions, such as schools, head start programs, before or after school programs, childcare centers, hospitals, clinics, hospices, nursing homes, recreation centers, senior centers, adult day care programs, homeless shelters, and food banks.
2. Nonprofit organizations such as Boy or Girl Scouts, 4-H Clubs, Police Activities League (PAL), organized children's recreation, mentoring, or education programs, Big Brothers/Big Sisters, and community clean-up programs.
3. Programs funded under the Older Americans Act, such as Service Corp of Retired Executives, senior meal programs, and senior centers.
4. Public or nonprofit organizations dedicated to seniors, youth, residents, special-needs populations and organizations with missions to enhance the environment, historic resources, cultural identities, neighborhoods or performing arts.
5. Your apartment complex to improve ground or provide gardens (TVIP)
